Founded by Roger Daltrey and Pete Townshend from the legendary rock band **The Who** [Link: https://teencanceramerica.org/about-us/our-founders/], Teen Cancer America's Play It Back music program uses music therapy as a principal tool in a highly structured recovery plan.

The program provides artists with weekly online creative sessions with an LA-based recording producer. They collaborate to create fully produced songs which are compiled into digital recordings to be distributed online and manufactured into CD and vinyl LP recordings. To-date, Nathan has completed a total of (11) original and fully produced songs.
